As our students and staff prepare to put the finishing touches on the 2019-20 school year, our Board of Education met last night to discuss what the future holds. Please read on...

<u>COVID-19 Update</u>: May 18th's <u>order from Public Health Madison and Dane County</u> has identified what is/is not acceptable for public education. The name of PHMDC's plan is "<u>Forward Dane</u>," and you may know we are currently in Phase 1 (see pages 10-15). I love hearing the many suggestions people have for gatherings, fall sports, class/retiree recognitions, parades, etc. As you can see from the plan, we are not permitted to do as other neighboring counties might be. I would love nothing more than to say, "YES!!!" Sometimes decisions are made for us. As we get your thoughtful suggestions, we are carefully reviewing "Forward Dane," calling PHMDC, and speaking with other Dane County superintendents to confirm what is possible. Keep the questions and ideas coming, please.

In order to get your ideas about your feeling related to the start to the school year (September 1, 2020), I want to remind you of the community survey we are administering. If you have not already done so, won't you please take some time before June 3 to <u>complete this</u>?

Pickup/Drop Off of student/school materials has been scheduled. <u>This message</u> was sent out to families last week. Due to the pavement projects taking place I ask that students do not walk or ride bikes to obtain/return materials. If the schedule identified in the link does not work for your family, I am confident we can make something else work. Please connect with your student's principal.

Academic classes will continue online for previously enrolled students.
