

Board of Education Recap

July 28, 2020

Dear Vikings,

At the request of several people, the Board of Education met to hear a COVID-19 update and determine if their original plan to return to school was still prudent. After discussion and citizens' comments, a motion was made to return to school in an all "virtual, plus model." This will extend through the first quarter of the 2020-21 school year. The motion carried by a vote of 4-3.

I can absolutely empathize with the emotions people are experiencing (in support or in opposition to this difficult decision). I remain committed to working with our students, parents, and staff by enacting steps that will permit a rigorous and engaging virtual experience for our young people. A few random thoughts, please:

- 1. What is "virtual plus"? Our initial thought is to provide in-school experiences for some students with special needs, "at hope" students, students needing/requesting personal check-ins, and curricular areas that might need personalized and/or laboratory supports. The scope of students served will continue to evolve.
- Professional development for our staff will continue to serve as a centerpiece to our planning efforts. In fact, all teachers have been invited to attend several evening training opportunities beginning the week of August 3. This, coupled with our annual "Viking Voyage Week" and pre-service week trainings, will go a long way in meeting the additional trainings our staff has been seeking.
- 3. Each of the 11 District level work groups are in the process of pivoting their workflow in response to last night's decision. Leaders from each of the following groups will be on hand to answer questions at the next Board of Education meeting, August 3:
